Methodology

- Interviews were conducted with a randomly selected sample of 400 Iowans. A sample of 400 is the number generally used to sample major metropolitan areas and smaller states such as Iowa.
- Participants were selected through a random-digit dialing procedure. Random-digit dialing ensures that every household in the state of Iowa has an equal chance of being selected into the sample. Random-digit dialing also ensures that the sample is unbiased and reflects the population of the state of Iowa within a small margin of error.

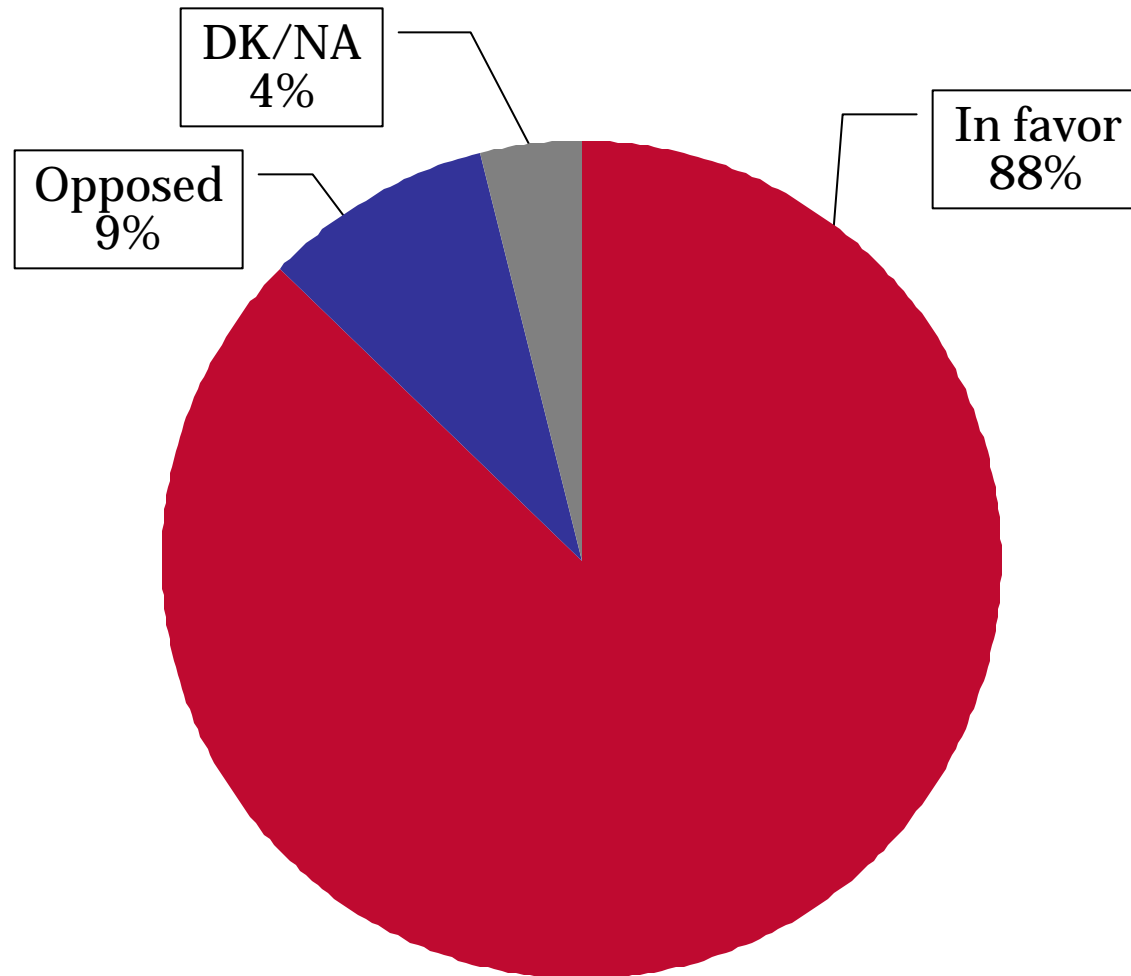
Methodology

- Interviews were conducted between January 8 and 11, 2002, from Frank N. Magid Associates' in-house WATS telephone facility and averaged 3 minutes.
- Participants qualified if they were at least 18 years old.

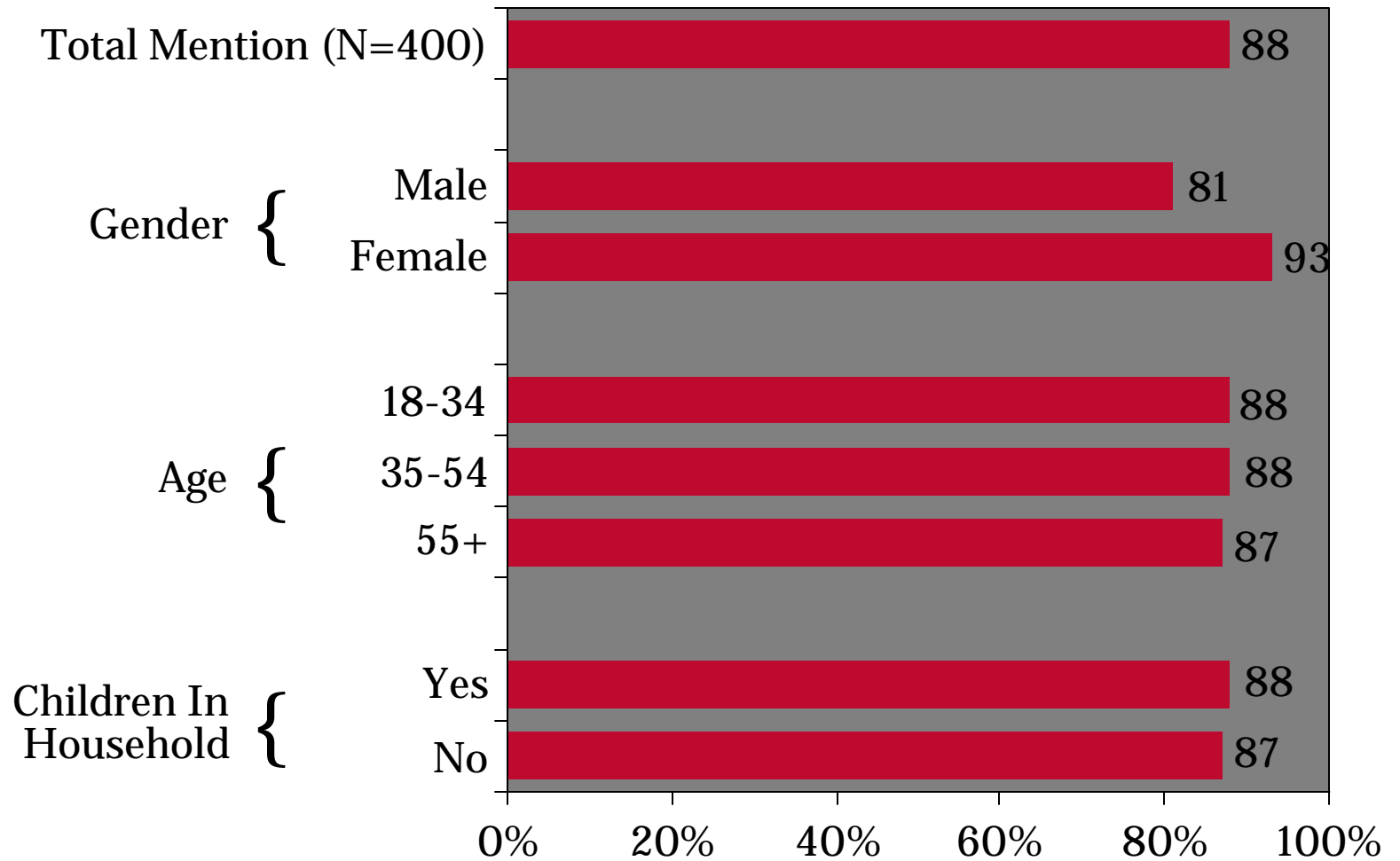
Most Iowans Support Law Requiring Criminal Background Checks

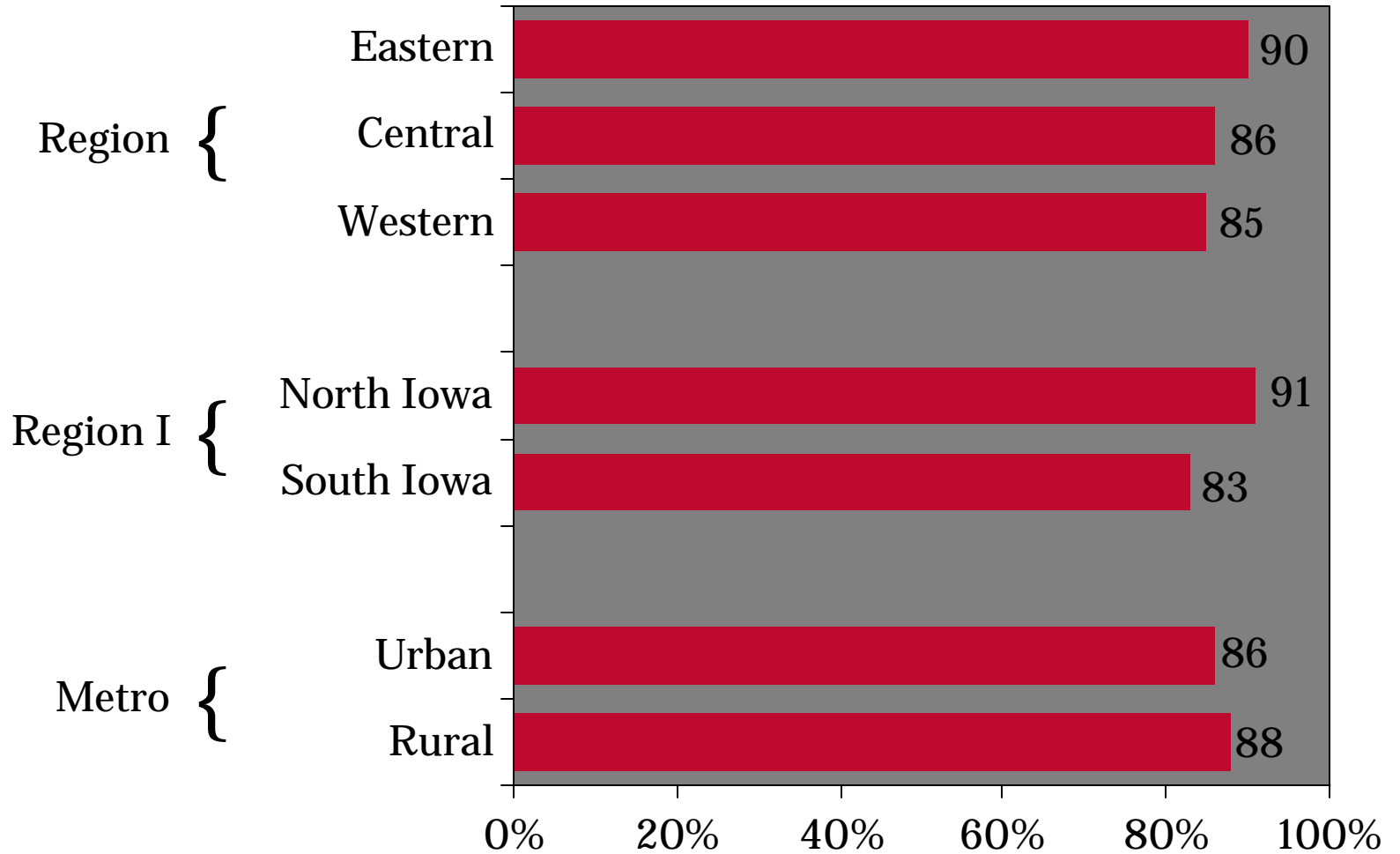
Support Of Law Requiring Criminal Background Checks – Demographics

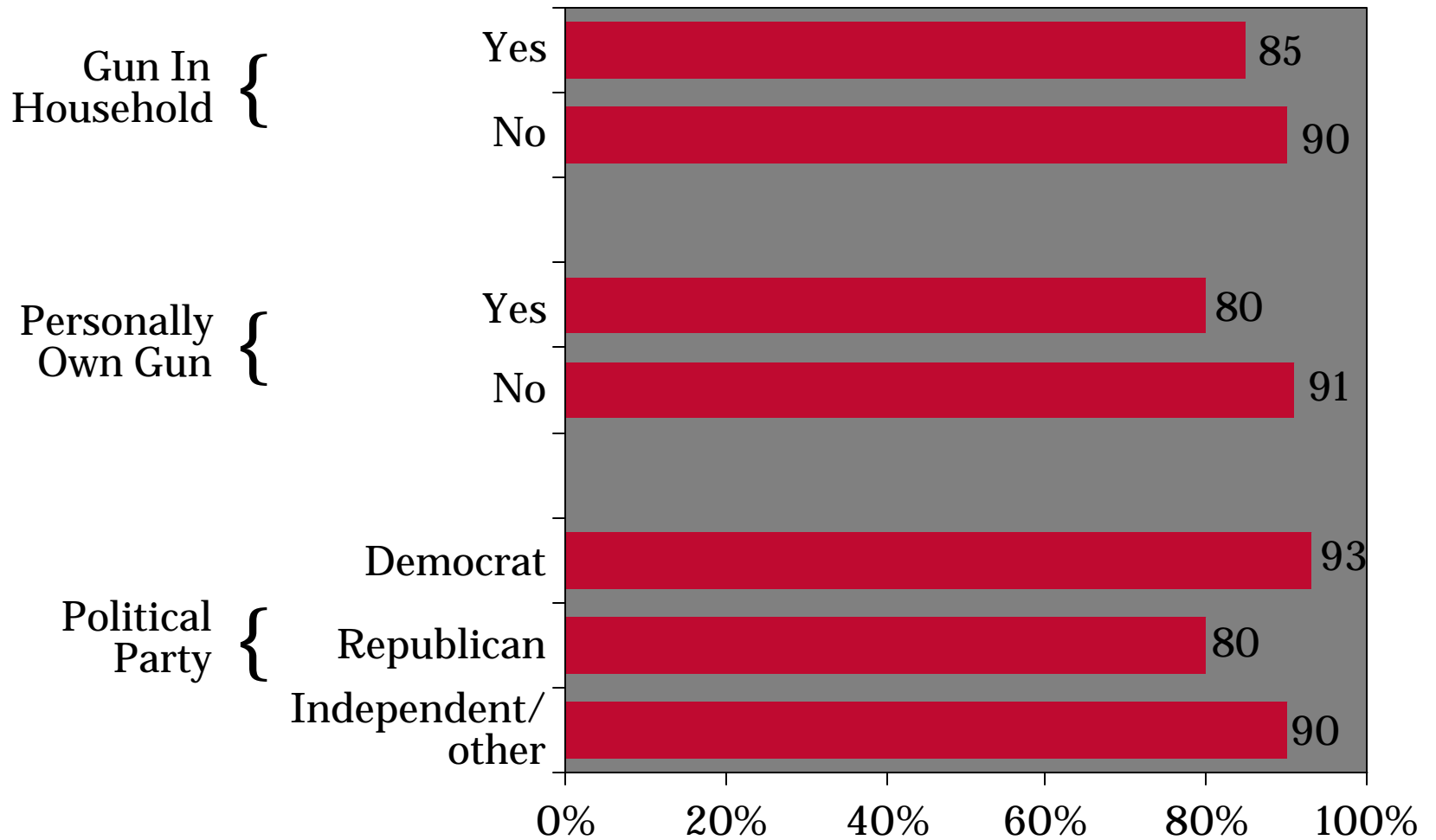

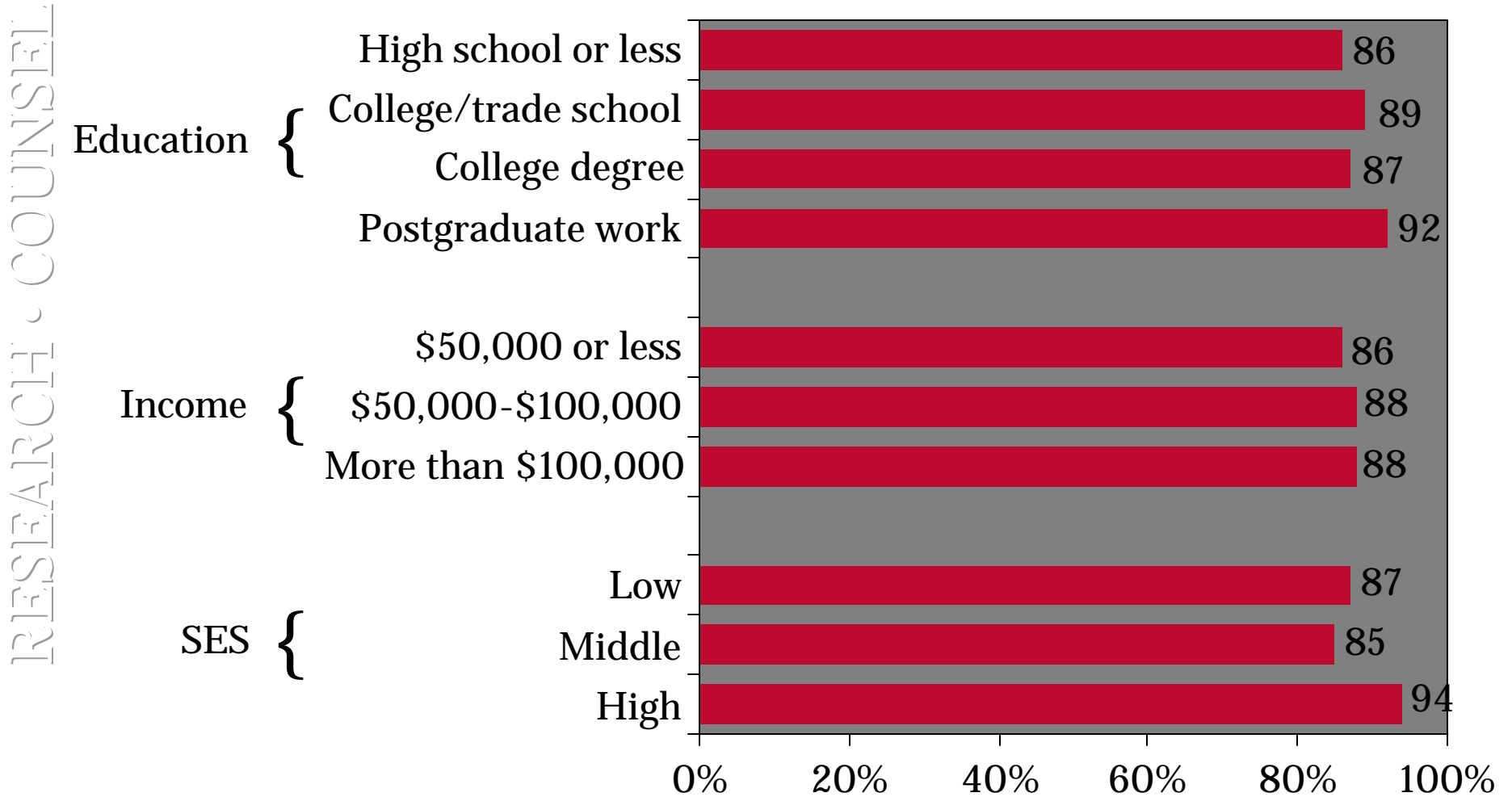

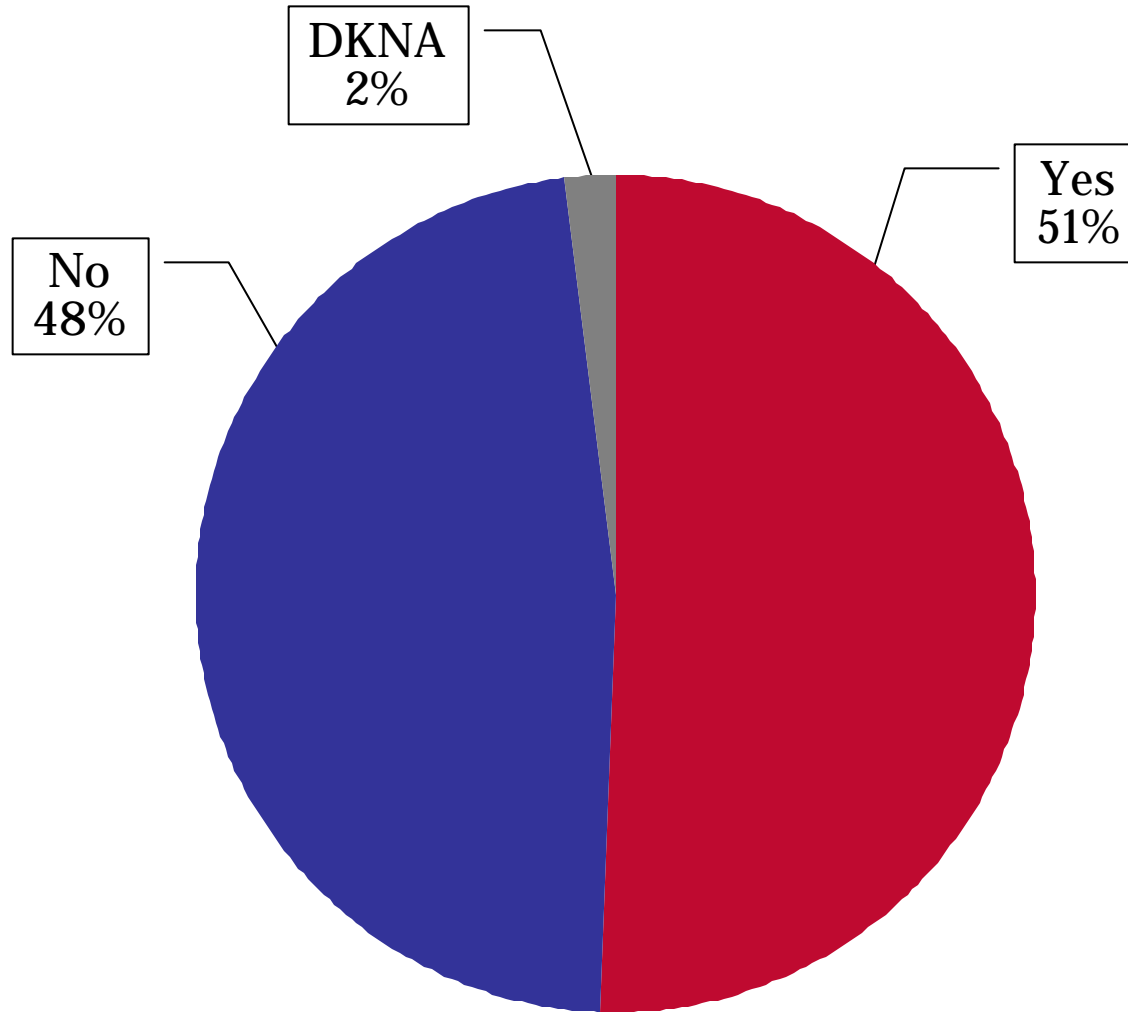

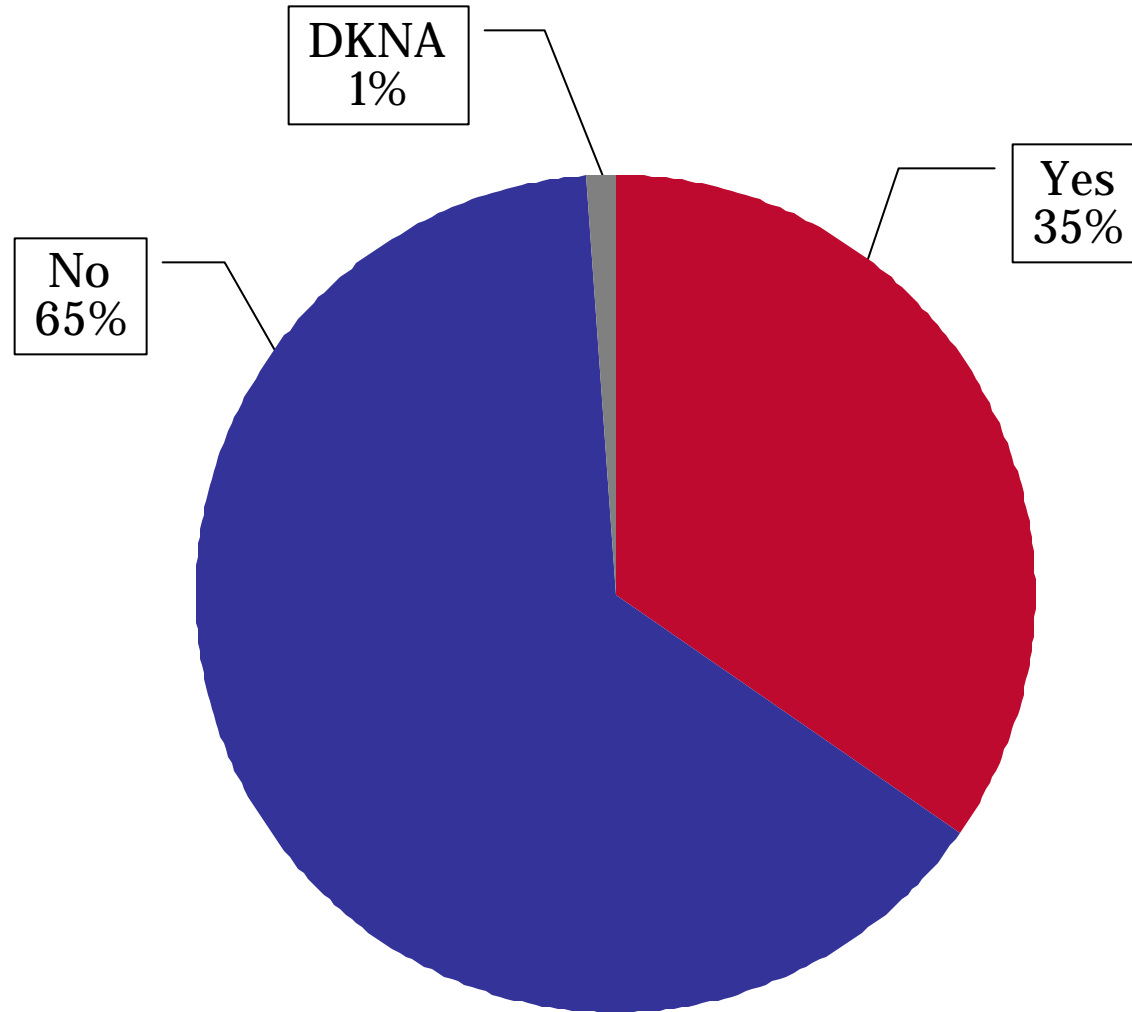
Guns In Household

Personally Own Firearm

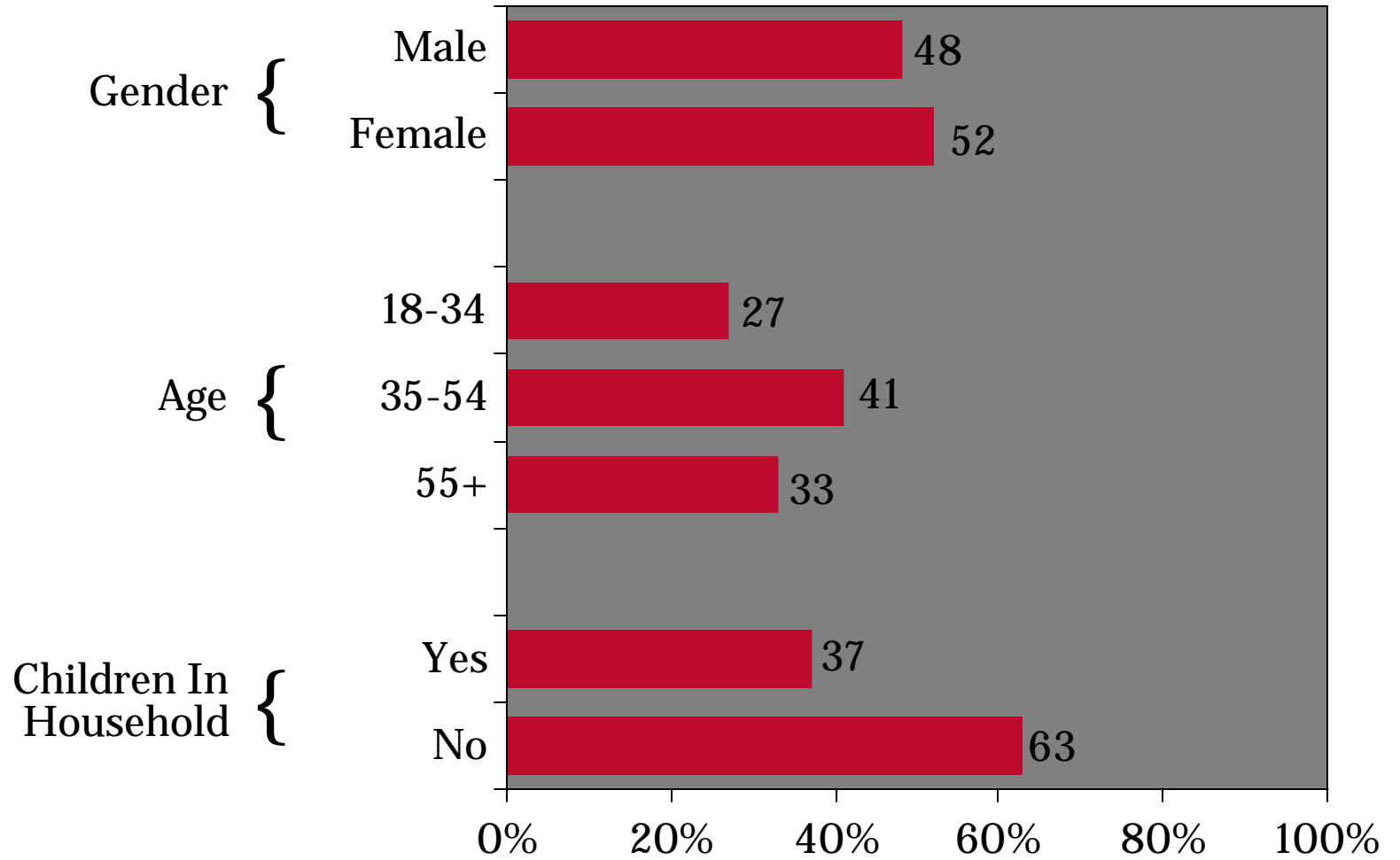

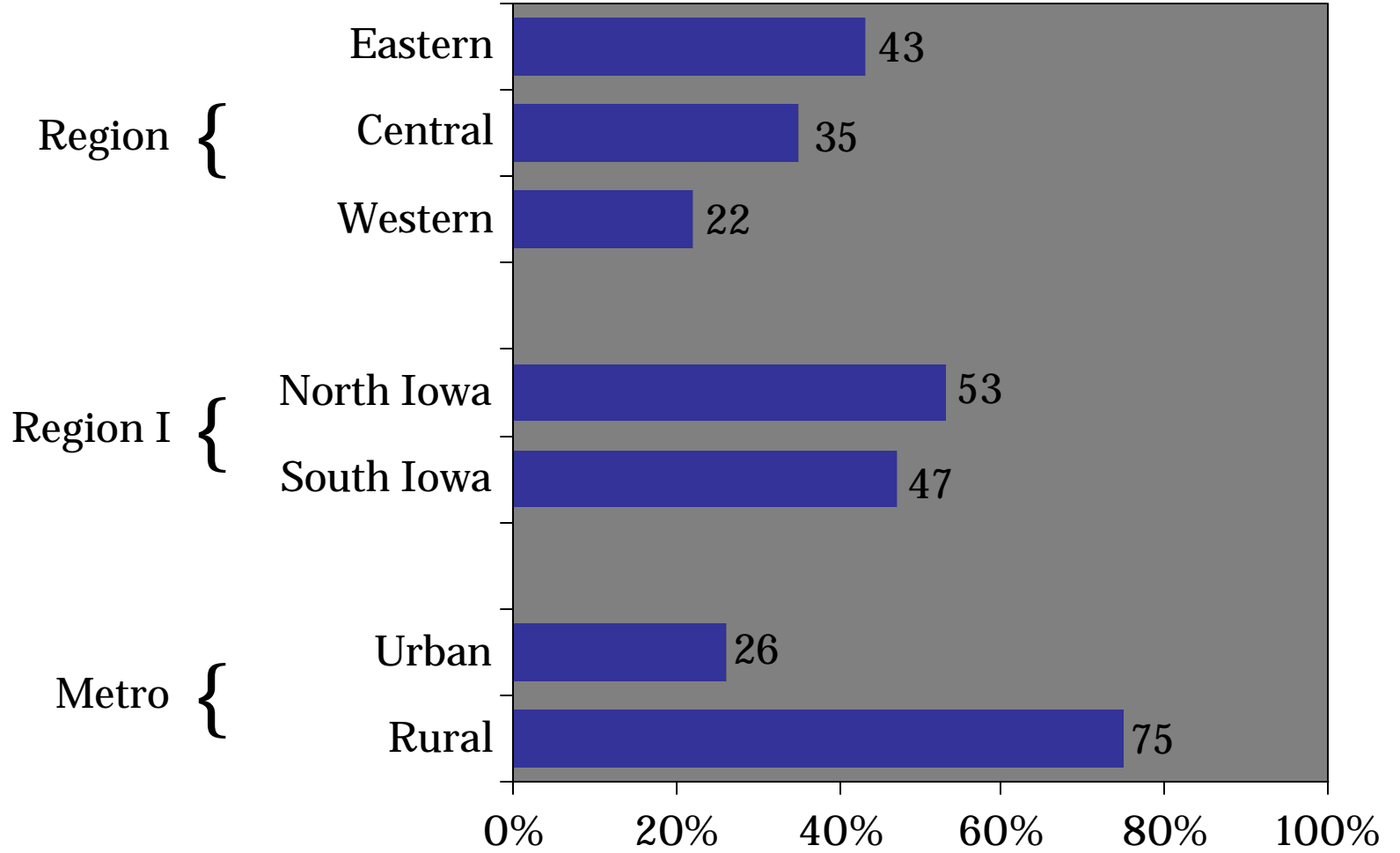

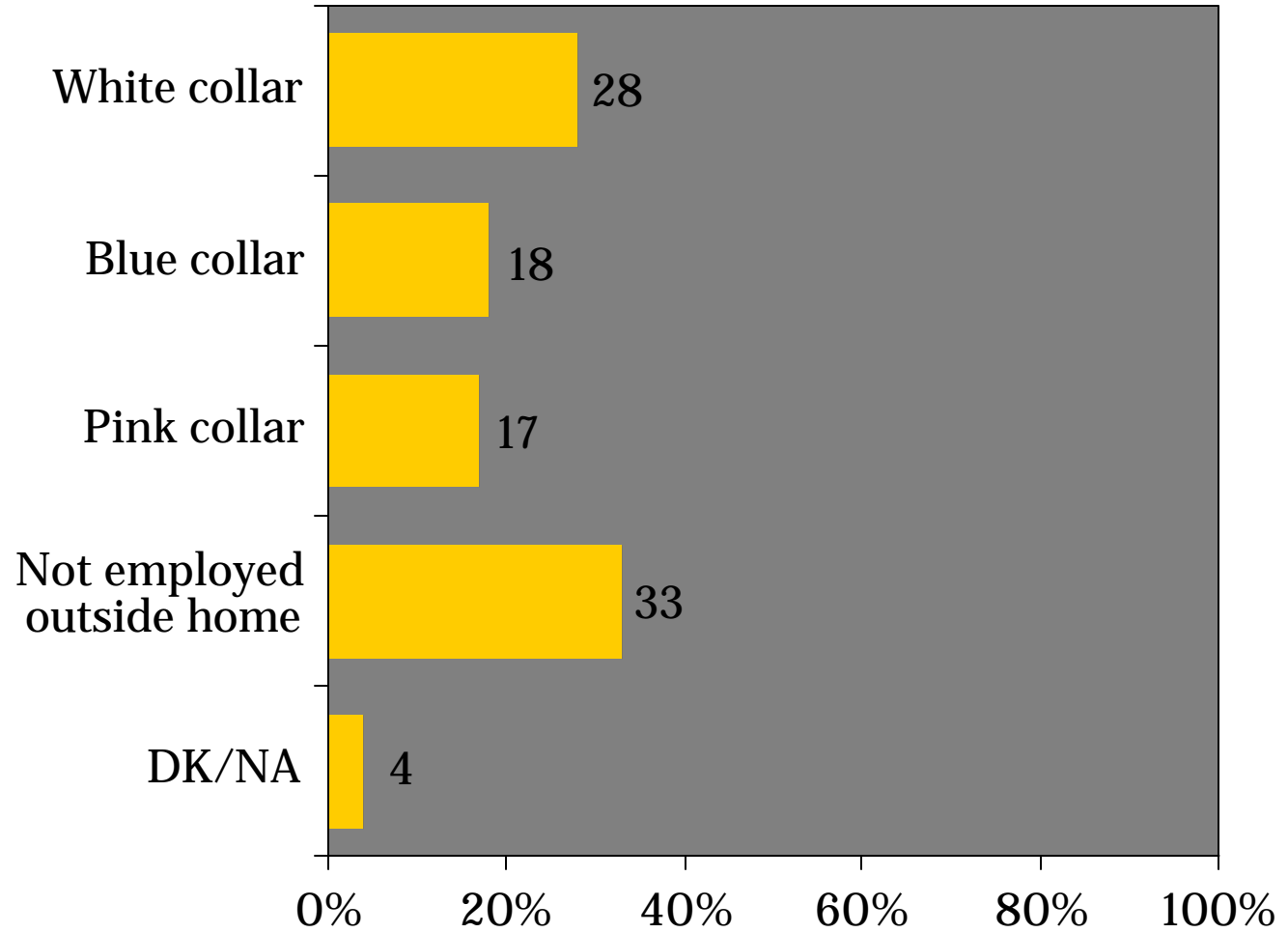
Political Party

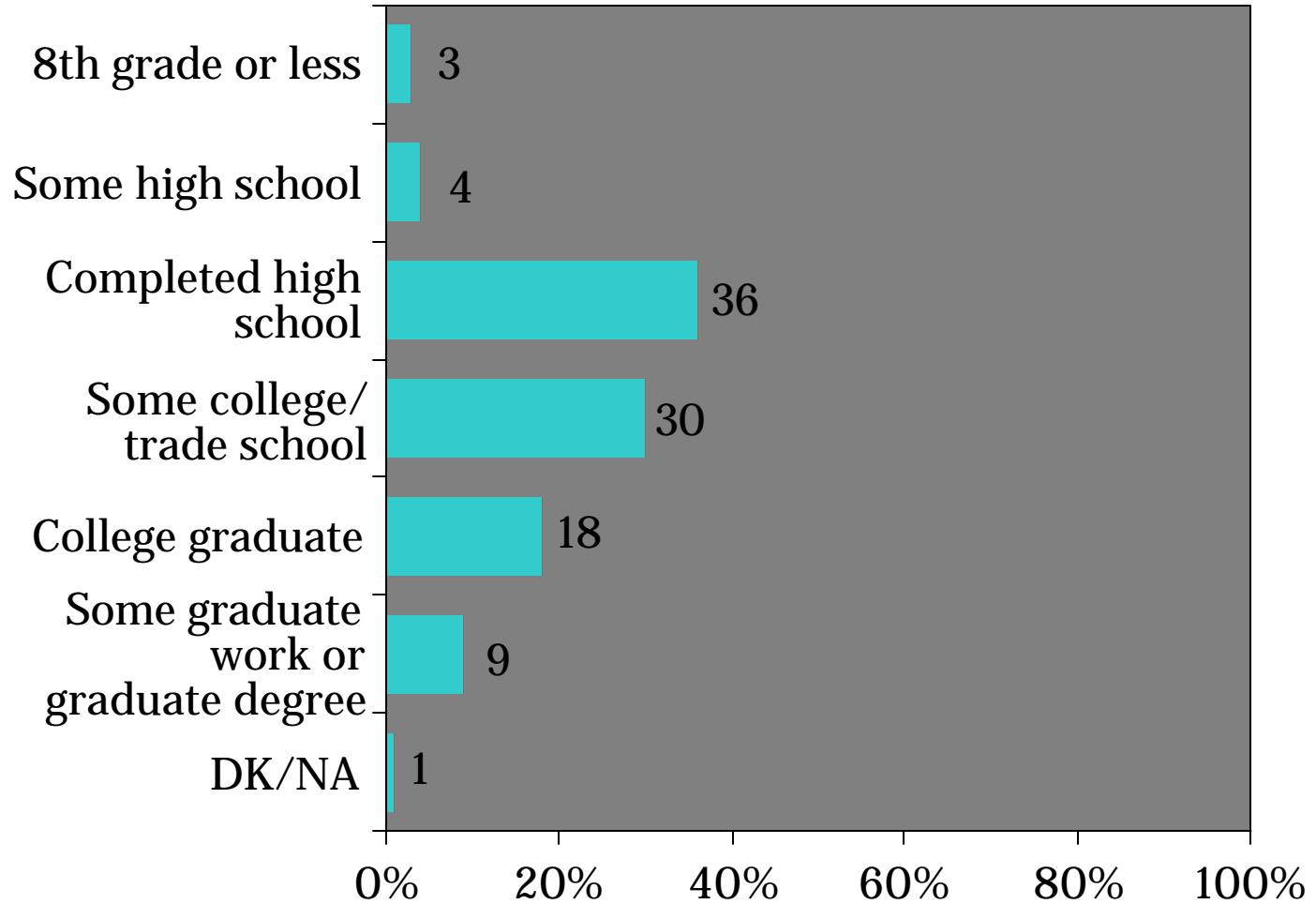

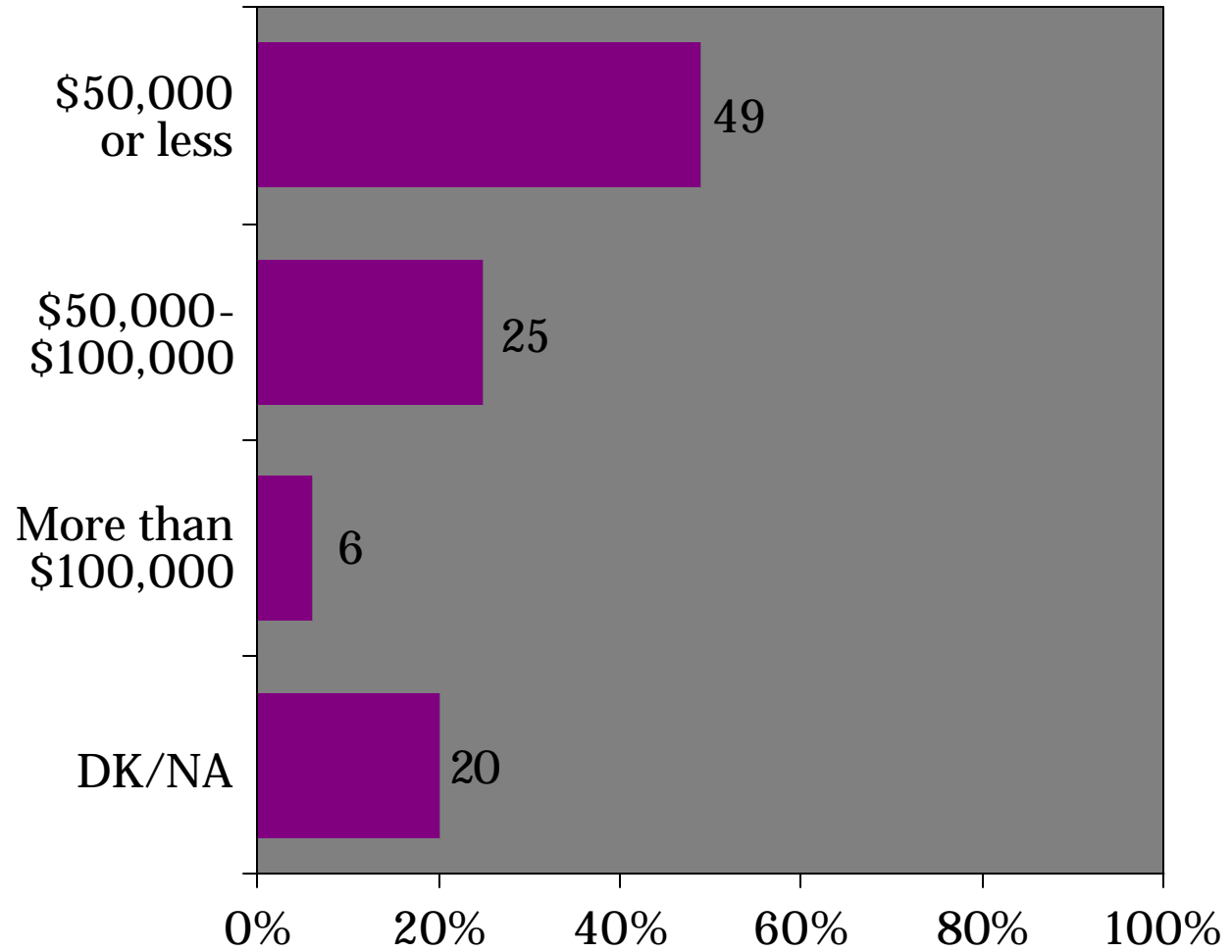

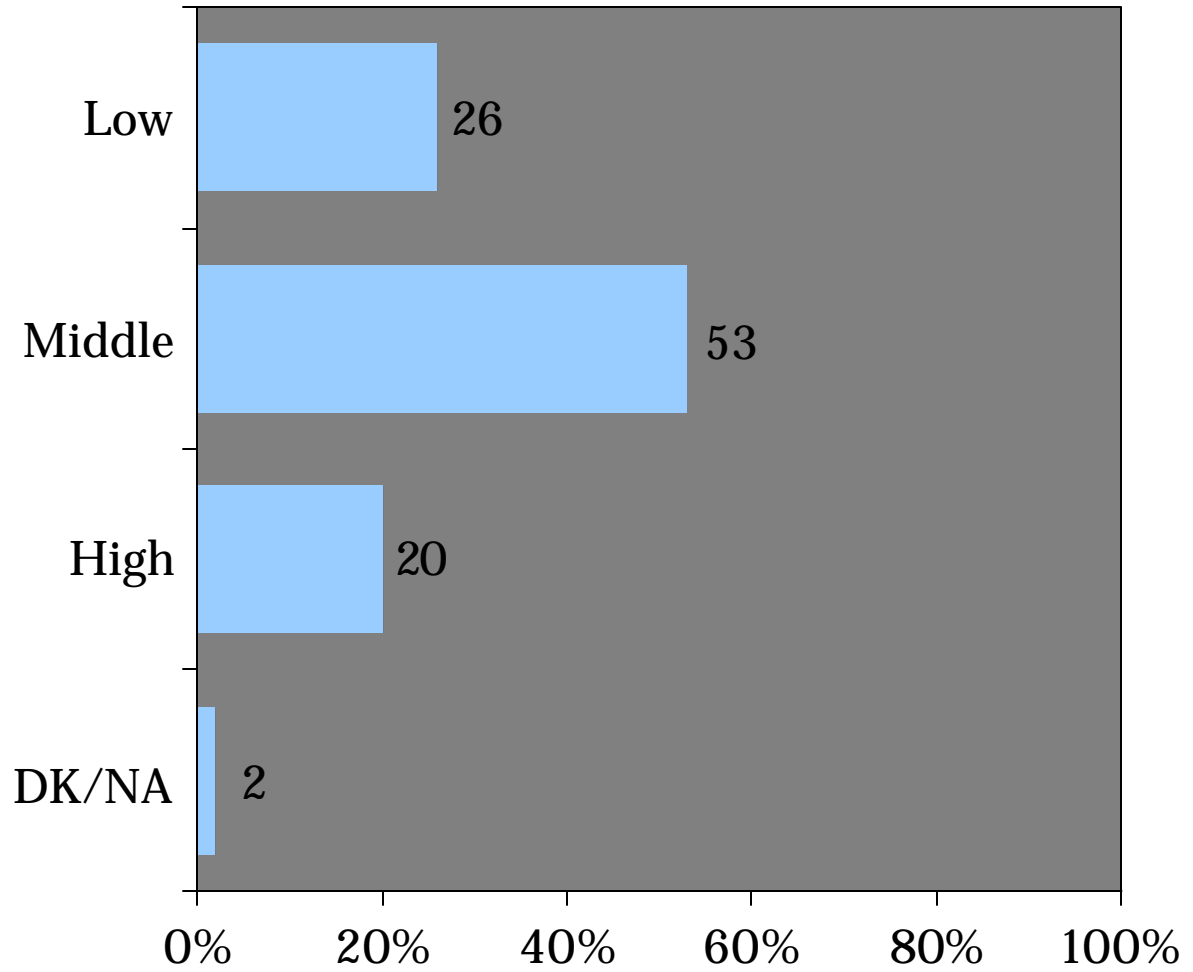
